Dear Ms. Dortch:

Aircraft Storage Solutions, LLC (“ASSL”) and New Inspiration Broadcasting Company, Inc. (“NIBC”) filed an assignment application with the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) on October 18, 2016, seeking to assign the construction permit for unbuilt FM Translator Station K279CM, Quartz Site, Arizona (Facility ID No. 157287) from ASSL to NIBC (File No. BAPFT-20161018AAG), which was granted on December 29, 2016.

NIBC filed a “250 Mile Modification” application for K279CM on October 18, 2016 (File No. BMPFT-20161018ABB). The purpose of the modification is to allow NIBC to rebroadcast KPRZ(AM), San Marcos-Poway, California, on the translator. After consummation and grant of the modification application, NIBC will build the modified translator promptly.

The K279CM Construction Permit is currently scheduled to expire on April 9, 2017. NIBC accordingly requests a waiver of the construction deadline for the Construction Permit pursuant to Footnote 36 of the FCC’s October 23, 2015 “AM Revitalization” Order, FCC 15-142, for six months from the later of the consummation of the assignment or the FCC grant of the above-referenced modification application.
