Status Inquiry

Dear Mr. Tucker:

This letter concerns the status of Station KXMQ(FM), McNary, Arizona (Station), licensed to Cochise Media Licenses, LLC (CML). Pursuant to Section 73.1740 of the Commission's Rules, you are required to clarify this matter in writing within thirty days of the date of this letter.

Our records show that the Station was granted its initial license on December 21, 2016, with the following condition:

Grant of this license application is conditioned on the continuous operation of the licensed facility for the twelve-month period following grant. The failure of the facility to so operate will result in the rescission of this grant, dismissal of the license application and the forfeiture of the associated construction permit pursuant to 47C.F.R. § 73.3598(c) unless the licensee rebuts the presumption that the authorized facilities were temporarily constructed.¹

According to a request for Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent (STA) filed on December 29, 2016, the Station is silent as of its initial licensing date, December 21, 2016. CML's Exhibit 1 attached to the application states:

KXMQ, while constructed and ready for operation, is silent while the licensee finalizes programming format and integration with its other properties in the market.²

Based on the above, further inquiry is required regarding the Station's construction and operational history. Please provide a copy of all station logs,³ all documents⁴ in the possession of CML, its principals, employees or agents relating or referring to equipment tests,⁵ and all

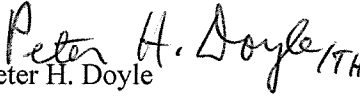

documents⁶ in the possession of CML, its principals, employees or agents relating or referring to program tests⁷ for the Station. Please provide evidence documenting proof of completion of the Station's construction, indicating the location, effective radiated power and antenna height above ground level. This documentation must also include vendor receipts, tower lease, studio lease, occupancy certificate, phone service, lease payments, invoices, bills, checks written or received, credit card charges, wire transfers or deposits of funds relating to the Station's construction. **You must also include** pictures of the Station's facilities, and provide exact Station coordinates.

Failure to respond to this letter within the specified time will result in adverse actions jeopardizing both the station's license and call letters.
