Dear Mr. Price:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 12, 2017. TMMO requests a further extension of the STA granted on November 12, 2013, as modified to operate with an emergency ND antenna due to required repairs. In support of the request, TMMO stated that additional time will be needed to resolve re-radiation problems from a solar farm and power lines.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

TMMO must submit an e-mail to the Audio Division staff to certify the date the station resumed licensed operations with negligible changes to the operating parameters after all problems have been resolved. Otherwise an FCC Form 302 application must be filed to update

all operating parameters.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and TMMO may continue to operate ND using tower #1 (ARSN 1224828) with a maximum of 0.625 kW day and 0.25 kW night. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. TMMO must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on August 2, 2017.
