Deportes y Musica Comunicaciones, LLC, the licensee of KRPH(FM), Morristown, AZ, by its undersigned counsel and pursuant to Rule 73.1635, hereby requests authorization for the station to go off-the-air and remain silent for a temporary period not to exceed 180 days so that it can relocate its main transmitter to a more desirable and cost-effective location.

The purpose of the relocation, for which a Form 301 was filed on February 6, 2017 (no file number yet assigned), is to improve both the quality and scope of the station's signal. The proposed relocation to Weaver Mountain is less than six kilometers from the current site of the station's main transmitter. No loss of service to its current audience is expected once the relocated transmitter is operational.

Because various lease agreements requiring ongoing payments either expire or require notices of termination or extension by the end of February 2017, expeditious Commission action on the instant application for STA is requested. The Anti-Drug Certification is included on page 2.
