Thank you so much for getting back to me and helping us with CDBS filing. As per our conversation, WLTQ (Facility Identification Number: 73874) in Charleston, SC was granted special temporary authority ("STA") on October 20, 2016 to operate station WLTQ(AM) with reduced power during daytime hours utilizing a backup transmitter after the main transmitter was thought to be water damaged by a passing hurricane. The main transmitter was cleaned up and put through a battery of tests to make sure it would be able to broadcast properly. After the transmitter was thoroughly tested, WLTQ 730 AM was returned to full power operation on February 20, 2017. Please allow this missive to serve as an adequate notification to the FCC that the STA may now expire and that WLTO is now in compliance with its FCC license.
