Dear Mr. Pugh:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 6, 2017. ER requests an extension of the STA granted on April 14, 2016, to the former licensee to continue operating using one of the four existing WERM(AM) towers pending the filing of the required FCC Form 301 application.¹ In support of the request, ER states that it plans to file the application to propose a new permanent facility using one of the WERM existing towers.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and ER may continue to operate with the following facilities:

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. ER must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47CFR 1.1310. We anticipate that ER will file the application in the upcoming months to show that substantial progress has been made.

This authority expires on August 24, 2017.
