Re: Notification of Resumption of Full Power Operation NCE Station KQVO(FM), Calexico, CA (Facility ID 8175)

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of the State of California, California State University, San Diego State University ("SDSU"), licensee of noncommercial educational radio station KQVO(FM), Calexico, California, we hereby inform the Commission that KQVO has resumed full power, licensed operation following a period of reduced power operation.

SDSU previously notified the Commission on September 30, 2016 in FCC File No. BSTA-20160930ABJ of KQVO's temporary reduced power status due to equipment problems, and requested Special Temporary Authority ("STA") for continued reduced power operation. The Commission granted reduced power STA for KQVO on October 6, 2016. SDSU now notifies the Commission that KQVO returned to full power, licensed operation as of February 24, 2017, such that the STA is no longer required. Station KQVO's HD2 and HD3 streams have also resumed regular operation.

SDSU is a noncommercial educational licensee and operates KQVO on a noncommercial educational basis. Moreover, SDSU is a governmental entity. The licensee is therefore exempt from FCC filing fee and regulatory fee requirements for KQVO, pursuant to Sections 1.1116 and 1.1162 of the Commission's rules.
