**ADDENDUM TO COMPLAINT REGARDING CO-CHANNEL INTERFERENCE
CAUSED BY TRANSMISSIONS OF FM TRANSLATOR STATION W252BE**

Marble City Media, LLC ("Marble City Media"), licensee of Station WFXO(FM), Stewartville, Alabama, by its counsel, hereby respectfully submits this Addendum to its February 10, 2017, Complaint Regarding Co-Channel Interference Caused by Transmissions of FM Translator Station W252BE licensed to Valleydale Broadcasting, LLC ("Addendum").

This Addendum provides copies of additional Listener Declarations or complaints of translator interference from regular listeners of WFXO(FM), an added *Engineering Statement*, and legal argument which together with the showing in the initial Complaint demonstrate that the Commission must immediately order W252BE off the air to avoid continuing disruption of service to the public served by WFXO(FM).¹ The continued illegal interference caused by FM Translator Station W252BE violates the express provisions of the Commission's rules and is contrary to the

public interest. As reflected in the *Engineering Statement*, complaining listeners are located well within the 60 dBu contour, and some are within the city grade contour of WFXO(FM). The *Engineering Statement* also clearly shows that W252BE is causing interference to 14.1 km of WFXO(FM)'s protected contour.

The failure of the licensee of W252BE, Valleydale Broadcasting, LLC, to contest the conclusions of the Complaint or to in any way address the harm it is causing to the public is yet another reason for the Commission to immediately order the translator off the air.

These new additional listener complaints demonstrate continuing interference to reception of WFXO(FM). Listener complaints are located within the 60 dBu contour of WFXO(FM) and importantly some are within its City Grade 70 dBu contour. It is beyond belief that listeners in the heart of an FM licensee's service area should be expected to suffer reception interference. Furthermore, as pointed out in the original Complaint, WFXO(FM) recently modified its license to operate in the area in which it is receiving interference from W252BE. WFXO(FM)'s current license was granted January 12, 2017. While the licensee has provided listener complaints, and can provide more, due to the newness of the FM station's service area, an extensive showing is unnecessary. It should be considered as a new FM station. Obviously, as a result of the debilitating interference in its 60 dBu service area and even its 70 dBu service area, as would a new station, Marble City Media is hampered in developing a listening base of new regular listeners for WFXO(FM) in the interference areas.

The uncontested facts presented by Marble City Media as to the W252BE translator and full service FM Station WFXO(FM) should be enough to show that the license for W252BE could not be granted at its current license parameters if it were filed today.² The *Engineering Statement*

provided in the Complaint and the supplemental *Engineering Statement* attached to this Addendum clearly show that W252BE does not comply with Section 74.1204 of the Commission's rules in that W252BE does not protect WFXO(FM)'s 60 dBu contour. See Statement of Mark M. Snow. The Statement clearly shows that not only does W252BE's 40 dBu contour overlap WFXO(FM)'s 60 dBu contour but also utilizing Longley-Rice Predicted Interference that interference will be received by WFXO(FM) if W252BE continues to operate as currently licensed. *Id.* Under either showing, the translator's operation expressly violates the Commission's rules and policies and must cease operations.

Accordingly, for the foregoing reasons, it is clear that translator station W252BE is causing disruptive interference to listeners of full power FM Station WFXO and violating the Commission's rules and policies. The public interest will be served by cessation of operation of the translator. Marble City Media respectfully renews its request that the Commission immediately order the FM translator to cease on-air operations and not resume operation until it can demonstrate that interference will not occur and that it can operate in accordance with the Commission's rules and policies.


As an addendum to the Exhibit A in the February 10, 2017 Complaint, attached as **Exhibit A**, is a map showing the predicted 60 dBu protected Contour of Station WFXO (Light Blue), the predicted 70 dBu Contour (Red), the predicted areas of interference from FM translator Station W252BE (Bright Green) and the locations of listener complaints (Yellow Pins). These locations include those in the February 10 Exhibit A, and new locations from more recent complaints. Further, text of emails from listeners complaining of interference are also attached.

Attached as **Exhibit B**, is a map showing calculated interference overlap curves and the contours of both Stations WFXO and W252BE assuming operations by the stations in accordance with the license of each.

Attached as **Exhibit C**, is an overlap study showing that W252BE's 40 dBu contour is overlapping the protected contour of WFXO(FM) by 14.1 km.

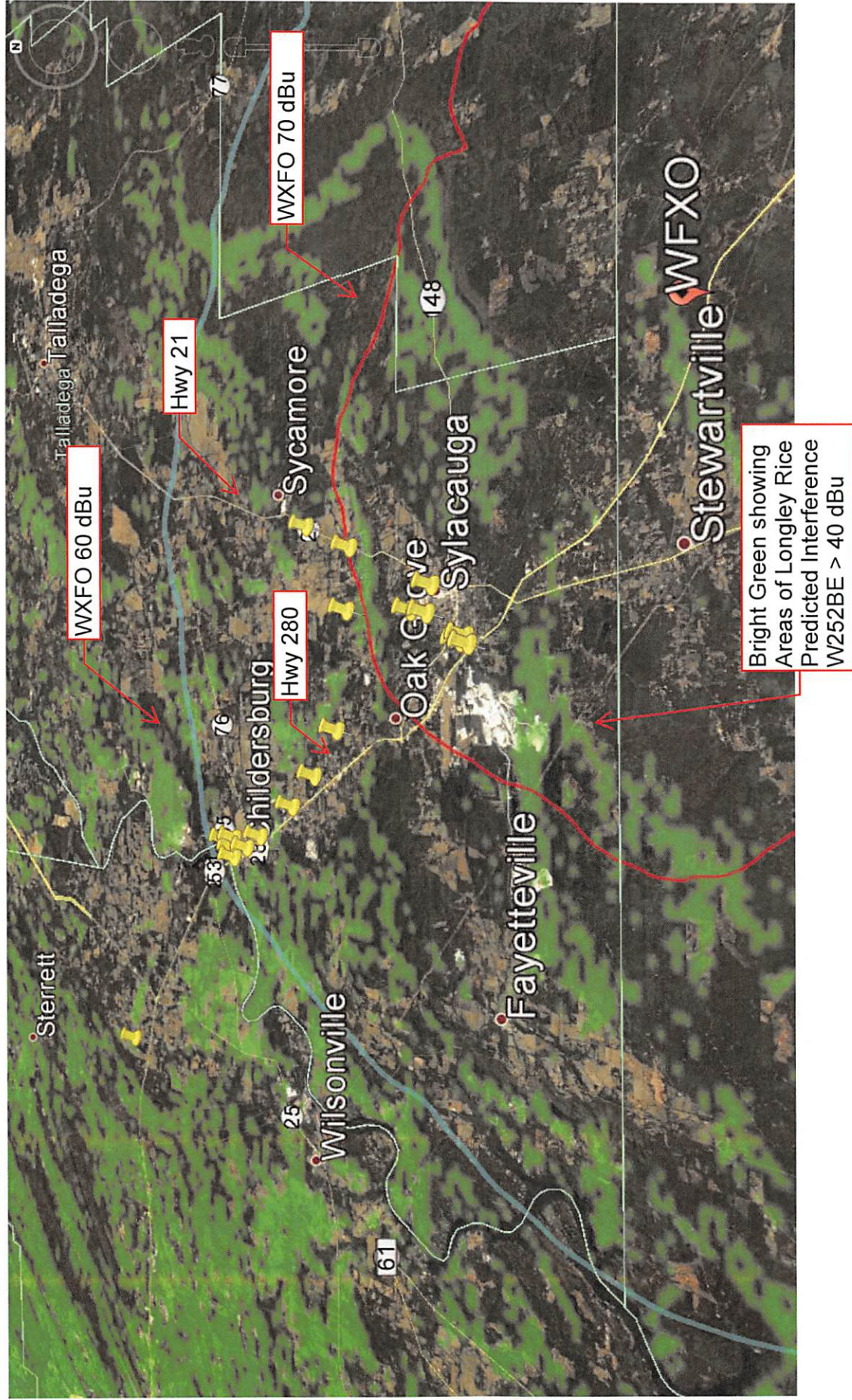

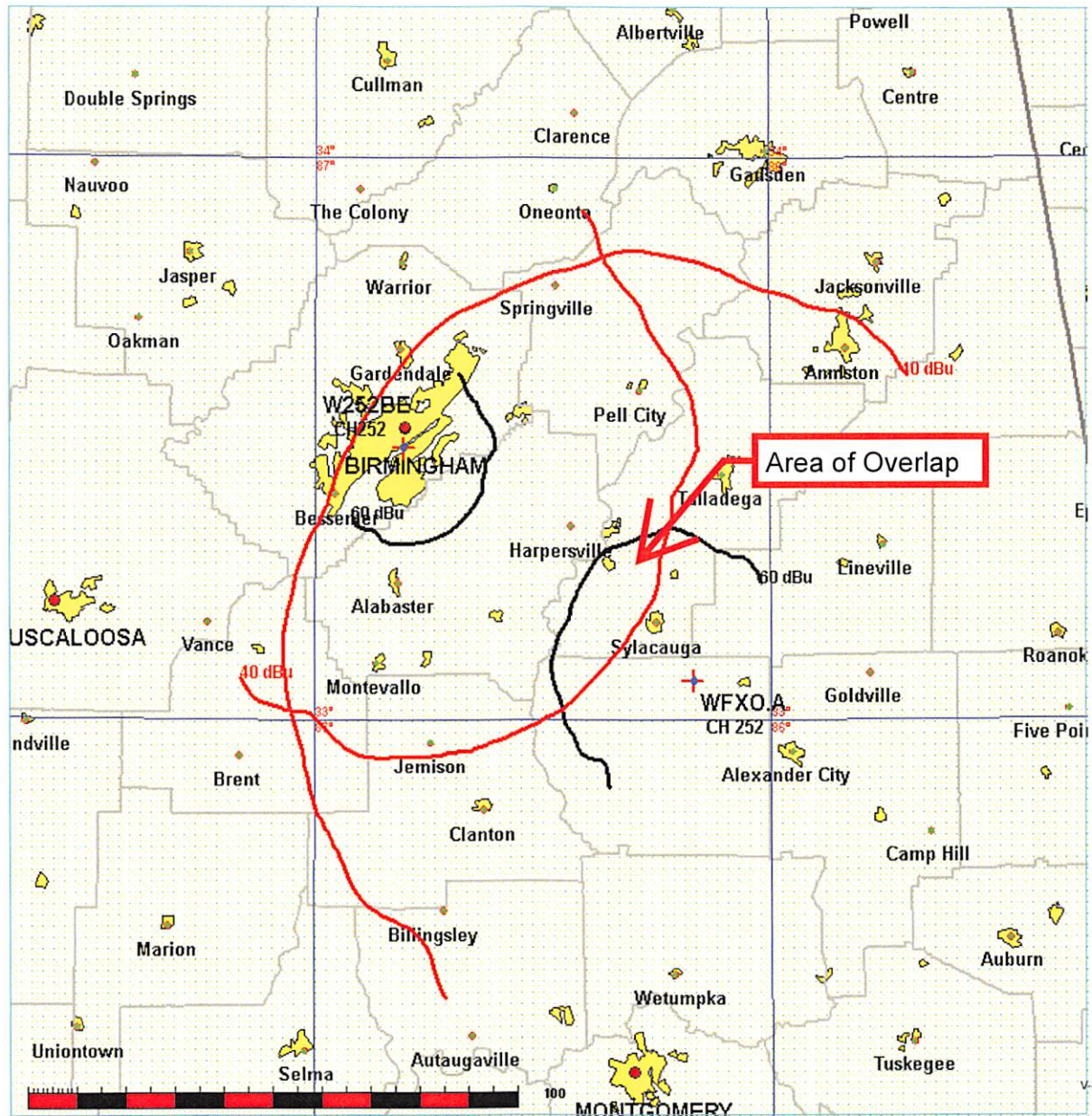


