STANDARD BROADCAST STATION LICENSE

Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, subsequent Acts, and Treaties, and Commission Rules made thereunder, and further subject to conditions set forth in this license, ^{1/}the LICENSEE

WELF RADIO, INC.

is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting apparatus hereinafter described for the purpose of broadcasting for the term ending 3 a.m. Local Time February 1, 1976

The licensee shall use and operate said apparatus only in accordance with the following terms:

1. On a frequency of 1590 kHz.
2. With nominal power of - watts nighttime and 1 kilowatts daytime,
with antenna input power of - watts - directional [- current - amperes
antenna nighttime [- resistance - ohms,
and antenna input power of 1 kilo watts non directional [antenna current 4.43 amperes
antenna daytime [antenna resistance 51 ohms

4. With the station located at: South Daytona, Florida
5. With the main studio located at:
Nova Rd., near intersection
with Reed Canal Road, South Daytona Beach, Florida
6. The apparatus herein authorized to be used and operated is located at: North Latitude: 29 ° 09 ' 16 "
Nova Road, near intersection West Longitude: 81 ° 01 ' 20 "
with Reed Canal Road
South Daytona Beach, Florida

7. Transmitter(s):

or other transmitter currently listed in the Commission's "Radio Equipment List, Part B, Aural Broadcast Equipment" for the power herein authorized).

8. Obstruction marking specifications in accordance with the following paragraphs of FCC Form 715: none required.

9. Conditions: -

ANTENNA: 150' (153' overall height) uniform cross section, guyed, series excited vertical steel tower. Ground system consists of 120 equally spaced buried copper radials 125' to 195.3' in length plus 24' by 24' ground screen.

The Commission reserves the right during said license period of terminating this license or making effective any changes or modification of this license which may be necessary to comply with any decision of the Commission rendered as a result of any hearing held under the rules of the Commission prior to the commencement of this license period or any decision rendered as a result of any such hearing which has been designated but not held, prior to the commencement of this license period.

This license is issued on the licensee's representation that the statements contained in licensee's application are true and that the undertakings therein contained so far as they are consistent herewith, will be carried out in good faith. The licensee shall, during the term of this license, render such broadcasting service as will serve public interest, convenience, or necessity to the full extent of the privileges herein conferred.

This license shall not vest in the licensee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequency designated in the license beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by Section 606 of the Communications Act of 1934.

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

UNLESS YOU OBJECT, the license of station WZIP, SOUTH DAYTONA, FL will be modified pursuant to Section 316(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, to specify nighttime operation. This will permit you to operate at night beginning on the date set forth below with a nominal power of 32.0 watts. (Instructions for calculating the actual operating power are enclosed.)

IF YOU AGREE TO THIS MODIFICATION, it will be necessary to follow the enclosed instructions and to send the required notification to the Commission before nighttime operation can begin.

-- NIGHTTIME OPERATION FOR YOUR STATION CAN BEGIN ON December 1, 1987 . --

IF YOU OBJECT TO THIS MODIFICATION you may, pursuant to SECTION 1.87 of the Commission's Rules, request that a hearing be held on the proposed modification or file a written statement in opposition to the modification proposed in this Order to Show Cause. In such case, the Commission will conclude that Station WZIP does not wish to have nighttime operation, and the station license will not be so modified. Instead, it will retain its current daytime-only authorization.

----- THE DEADLINE FOR FILING SUCH AN OBJECTION IS January 4, 1988. -----

PLEASE NOTE: In the event the Commission receives no written opposition to the proposed modification, the right to a hearing will be considered to have been waived, and the licensee of Station WZIP will be deemed to have consented to the modification. In such case, the station must begin nighttime operation within a year of the date of this order in compliance with the rules applicable to such operation.
