We respectfully request a 30 to 60 day extension of the construction permit mentioned herein.

All of the necessary equipment to complete the purposed construction has been ordered and delivered.

As of this writing, we have experienced a failure of a power module of the allocated transmitter for the station. The module will be replaced/repared.

While we anticipated the construction to be completed during the calendar year 2016, we have notified the Commission previously, the licensee's officers and engineers have experienced significant personal health problems and, as such, have executed the station's construction as their health has allowed.


