Dear Mr. Do:

This is in reference to the request filed on April 20, 2017. Intelli requests a further extension of the STA granted on September 17, 2014, to operate with temporary facilities pending the filing of the required FCC Form 301 application to propose a new permanent facility (due to loss of the licensed site).¹ In support of the request, Intelli states that additional time is needed to file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and Intelli may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Frequency	1290 KHz
Hours of operation	Unlimited


¹ KAZA(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1290 kHz with 5 kW day and 0.088 kW night.

Operating power	1.25 kW (day), 0.02 kW (night)
Antenna type	Existing tower of KZSJ(AM), ID#30906
Antenna efficiency	307 mV/m/km/kW

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. Intelli must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **November 17, 2017**.
