STANDARD BROADCAST STATION LICENSE

Subject to the provisions of the Communications Act of 1934, subsequent Acts, and Treaties, and Commission Rules made thereunder, and further subject to conditions set forth in this license, ¹/_{the} LICENSEE

Mid America Broadcasting, Inc.

is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting apparatus hereinafter described for the purpose of broadcasting for the term ending 3 a.m. Local Time December 1, 1989

The licensee shall use and operate said apparatus only in accordance with the following terms:

1. On a frequency of 1230 kHz.
2. With nominal power of 250 watts nighttime and 1 kilo watts daytime,
with antenna input power of 250 watts nondirectional
antenna nighttime [Antenna current 1.91 amperes
and antenna input power of 1 kilo watts non directional [Antenna resistance 68 ohms,
antenna daytime [Antenna current 3.83 amperes
[Antenna resistance 68 ohms
3. Hours of operation: Unlimited

Average hours of sunrise and sunset provided with previous authorization

4. Station location: Moline, Illinois

5. Main studio location:

7. Transmitter location: 7th Street extension North Latitude: 41 ° 28' 54 "
just beyond Moline City Line, Illinois West Longitude: 90 ° 31' 49 "

Antenna: 208; (208' overall height) tapered, self-supporting, shunt excited, vertical radiator with two communications-type antenna side-mounted near the top. Ground system consists of 120 equally spaced copper wire radials 108 to 200' long plus 30 radials 50' long interspaced between radials less than 200'.

8. Obstruction marking specifications in accordance with the following paragraphs of FCC Form 715: 1, 3, 12 and 21.

9. Transmitter(s): Type accepted

10. Conditions: Licensee shall accept such interference as may be imposed by other existing 250 watt Class IV station in the event they are subsequently authorized to increase power to 1 kilowatts.

The Commission reserves the right during said license period of terminating this license or making effective any changes or modification of this license which may be necessary to comply with any decision of the Commission rendered as a result of any hearing held under the rules of the Commission prior to the commencement of this license period or any decision rendered as a result of any such hearing which has been designated but not held, prior to the commencement of this license period.

This license is issued on the licensee's representation that the statements contained in licensee's application are true and that the undertakings therein contained so far as they are consistent herewith, will be carried out in good faith. The licensee shall, during the term of this license, render such broadcasting service as will serve public interest, convenience, or necessity to the full extent of the privileges herein conferred.

This license shall not vest in the licensee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequency designated in the license beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by Section 606 of the Communications Act of 1934.
