is hereby authorized to use and operate the radio transmitting apparatus hereinafter described for the purpose of broad-

casting for the term beginning June 21, 1960, and ending April 1, 1961
(3 a.m. Eastern Standard Time) (3 a.m. Eastern Standard Time)

The licensee shall use and operate said apparatus only in accordance with the following terms:

1. On a frequency of 1410 kc.
2. With 500 watts power non directional antenna nighttime current, - amperes

 resistance, 101.2 ohms

Neither the license nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This license is subject to the right of use or control by the Government of the United States conferred by section 606 of the Communications Act of 1934.
