FURTHER MOTION TO DISMISS

Patrick M. Sullivan ("Sullivan"), by its attorney, pursuant to Section 73.3568 of the Commission's Rules, hereby requests the immediate dismissal of the above-captioned assignment application with prejudice because, as explained below, the underlying Purchase Agreement has been terminated and the station is being sold to a third party, instead of Lake Broadcasting, Inc. Under these circumstances, this request terminates the participation of Mr. Sullivan in MB Docket No. 14-82 and should result in the dismissal of the subject assignment application and the immediate termination of this proceeding. In support whereof, the following is shown:

1. On May 13, 2012, Mr. Sullivan signed a Purchase Agreement (copy attached) with Michael S. Rice, President of Lake Broadcasting, Inc. to purchase FM Translator Station W238CE. An assignment application was duly filed on May 23, 2012, and that application is the

subject of the hearing proceeding in MB Docket No 14-82. The Purchase Agreement allows

either party to terminate the agreement if Closing does not occur on or before November 13,

2012. Mr. Sullivan has decided that he can wait no longer to sell his station. So, by the attached

Declaration under penalty of perjury, he notified Lake today that he is terminating the Purchase

Agreement as of today and instead is selling Station W238CE to Terry Barber. See attached

Declaration by Mr. Sullivan.

2. WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing and in accordance with his Declaration,

Patrick Sullivan hereby requests the Presiding Judge (or the Commission's Media Bureau, as

appropriate) to dismiss the assignment application File No. BALFT-20120523ABY for Station

W238CE immediately and with prejudice, so that Mr. Sullivan can file a new FCC Form 345

assignment application to sell the station to Terry Barber.
