This is in reference to the request filed April 19, 2017, on behalf of New York Public Radio ("NYPR"). NYPR requests special temporary authority ("STA") to operate station WNYC(AM) during nighttime hours with the antenna system authorized in BP-20140106DLJ. NYPR states that the station completed construction of the permit on June 9, 2014 and pursuant to Section 73.1615(b)(6) WNYC(AM) began operating with the adjusted nighttime pattern and power not exceeded that authorized in its license. NYPR states that by letter dated June 24, 2014, it notified the Commission pursuant to 73.1615(c)(1) that it intended to continue operation of WNYC(AM) as authorize in the permit beyond the 30-day period provided in the rule, in order to fully assess the impact of the change in antenna pattern on its coverage of the market.

After the request was reviewed, NYPR was asked to provide additional information as to why the station could not currently go back to operating with licensed facilities. NYPR responded to the request and on May 6, 2017 WNYC(AM) resumed operation per its current license (BMML-20131031AHM). Thus, the STA request (BSTA-20170419AID) is now dismissed as moot.
