Dear Madam Secretary,

The School Board of the School District for Whitefish Bay was awarded a construction permit, Construction Permit BNPL-20131114BET, for construction of a LPFM broadcast station. A copy of that permit is attached. The School District has attempted to raise the community support (financially and otherwise) necessary to construct and operate the station, but to no avail, despite the granting by the FCC of an extension of time for construction of the station. At the February 22, 2017, special meeting of the School Board for the School District of Whitefish Bay, the school board voted to relinquish the LPFM broadcast station construction permit. The motion and the minutes documenting the passage of that motion are attached to this letter. As a result of this board's vote, the School Board for the School District of Whitefish Bay does hereby permanently surrender its LPFM construction permit, BNPL-20131114BET. Further, the School Board for the School

District of Whitefish Bay hereby permanently surrenders its call sign, WFBW, which it was granted for the LPFM broadcast station.

In addition, it has come to the attention of the School Board for the School District of Whitefish Bay that a Transfer of Control Application, Transfer of Control Application, BTCL-20160414AAQ, was filed *without the knowledge and permission of the School Board for the School District of Whitefish Bay*. That Transfer of Control application is pending. The School Board for the School District of Whitefish Bay hereby requests that the pending Transfer of Control Application, BTCL-20160414AAQ be cancelled or dismissed.

We very much appreciated the opportunity open to us to construct and operate a LPFM broadcast station and regret that we are unable to do so. We further appreciate the professionalism and assistance rendered to us by a number of individuals at the FCC including those at the call sign desk and, most recently, Ms. Denise Williams.

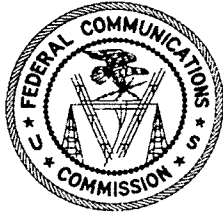

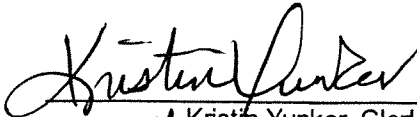
