This letter refers to the above-captioned minor change application filed by Educational Communications of Colorado Springs, Inc. ("ECCS") for noncommercial educational FM Station KRJX(FM) to change the transmitter location, effective radiated power (ERP) and antenna height. ECCS also proposes to change KRJX's antenna from a circularly polarized antenna (both horizontal and vertical polarization) to a vertically only polarized antenna.

Specifically, in Section VII, Items 7 through 10 of the application ECCS indicates that it is proposing the use of a vertically only polarized antenna. However, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.316(a), the vertical ERP cannot exceed the horizontal ERP. Specifically, § 73.316(a) states that it shall be standard to employ horizontal polarization. Section 73.316(a) further states that the supplemental vertically polarized ERP required for circular or elliptical polarization shall not exceed the ERP authorized. Section 73.525 of the Commission's Rules (47 C.F.R. § 73.525) makes an exception for FM stations that are required to protect a TV Channel 6 station. However, no TV Channel 6 stations, that require protection, are within the distances specified in § 73.525(a) to KRJX. Therefore, KRJX is not eligible for this exception. This constitutes an acceptability defect.

Accordingly, Application File No. BPED-20170515AAF IS HEREBY DISMISSED as unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3566(a). This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
