New Inspiration Broadcasting Company, Inc. (“NIBC”) filed a minor modification application with the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) on October 18, 2016, seeking to modify the facilities of FM Translator Station K279CM, Quartz Site, AZ (now K291CR, Encinitas, CA) (FCC Facility ID No. 157287), which was conditionally granted on May 15, 2017 (FCC File No. BMPFT-20161018ABB) (the “Construction Permit”), prior to the receipt of Mexican concurrence.

The Construction Permit currently is scheduled to expire on November 15, 2017, in connection with the January 23, 2017 waiver of expiration. NIBC accordingly requests tolling of the Construction Permit expiration date, until the pending Mexican concurrence is obtained.

NIBC certifies that it is not subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. Section 862.


