Special Temporary Authorization

Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed May 1, 2007, on behalf of Citicasters Licenses, L.P. ("Citicasters"). Citicasters requests further extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on August 31, 2005, to operate Station KWKH during nighttime hours with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits, and for operation with a nondirectional antenna and reduced power.¹ In support of the request, Citicasters states that it has completed substantial refurbishment of the station's nighttime directional antenna system and that it intends to file Form 302-AM in the near future.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made progress toward restoration of licensed operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is warranted. In light of the information provided, operation with an emergency nondirectional antenna is no longer necessary; the STA will be modified appropriately.

¹ KWKH is licensed for operation on 1130 kHz with 50 kilowatts, unlimited hours, employing a directional antenna during nighttime hours only (DA-N-U).

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KWKH may continue to operate during nighttime hours with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. Citicasters must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² Citicasters must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **January 19, 2008**.
