RE: Discontinued Operation of Translator K211EF

To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to FCC Rule 74.1263 – Time of operation, this letter serves as notification of translator K211EF, South Lake Tahoe, CA temporary discontinued operation.

On June 16, 2017 at 12:00 PM PDT translator K211EF, licensed to California State University, Sacramento was taken out of service due to a hardware problem.

After an AC power outage caused by a damaged power pole the transmitter was intermittently shutting down. Upon further investigation, we discovered a damaged power supply in the transmitter. Per the manufacturer of the transmitter, the power supply is no longer available and transmitter must be replaced. We are currently in the process of preparing a replacement transmitter.
