This letter refers to the above-captioned minor change application filed by North County Broadcasting Corporation (NCBC) to modify the licensed facility by changing patterns.

The FCC's International Bureau staff has informed the Audio Division that by letters dated November 28, 2006 (Mexico Ref #1139, #1138), Mexico has objected to the daytime proposal because it causes interference to first-adjacent stations XECL, Mexicali, and XEDX, Ensenada, Baja California North. It should be noted that the licensed KCEO facility was previously objected by Mexico. As a result, we recommend that NCBC file an amendment to eliminate all overlap with XEDX and XECL inside Mexico. Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty days from the date of this letter to provide an opportunity to file a curative electronic amendment. Failure to amend or respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3568.
