This authority is conditioned upon the licensee, Preservation Association of Beaver Island, immediately filing a new construction permit application on FCC Form 318, to replace the recently expired and cancelled permit BPL-20150825AAX.

Maximum ERP is limited to 0.055 kW (55 watts).

This STA authority expires **December 27, 2017**. Extensions of this authority are not contemplated.

**Considerations:**
