Dear Mr. Chiesa:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 16, 2017. RVCM requests a further extension of the STA granted on November 13, 2007, to continue operating at an alternate site pending the filing and grant of an FCC Form 302 application for license to cover BP-20140425AAA.¹ In support of the request, RVCM states that it plans to complete construction of the new site facility within the next few months.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and RVCM may continue to operate with the following facilities:

¹ WVZN is licensed for ND operation on 1580 kHz with 0.5 kW day and 0.005 kW night, and BP-20140425AAA proposes a new ND facility at a new site.

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. RVCN must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. RVCN may want to file a final short term STA extension to operate with parameters at variance using the new Valcom antenna once installed (before the license application has been granted), therefore a reduced amount of time using the current STA parameters noted above has been authorized.

This authority expires on **November 14, 2017**.
