Pursuant to FCC Rule 74.1263 – Time of operation, this letter serves as notification of translator K211EF, South Lake Tahoe, CA returned to operation.

As the commission's records reflect, on June 16, 2017, the transmitter for K211EF suffered a catastrophic failure. The power supply in the transmitter was damaged and replacement parts were not available. I am pleased to report as of July 7, 2017, the transmitter has been replaced and K211EF was returned to operation.
