Dear Mr. Davis:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 27, 2017. CCL requests a further extension of the STA granted on June 29, 2006, to operate with DA parameters at variance to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, CCL states that additional time is needed to complete and file the application due to a change in one monitoring point.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED and CCL may continue to operate with DA parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. CCL must use whatever means are



necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **January 27, 2018**.
