Dear Mr. Cherry:

This is in reference to the request filed on August 7, 2017. Cherry requests a further extension of the STA originally granted on February 10, 2015, to operate with temporary facilities at an alternate site to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application (since unable to complete repairs at the licensed site). In support of the request, Cherry states that additional time is needed to avoid cancellation of the station's license (by filing the required application for a new permanent facility).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and Cherry may continue to operate with the following facilities pending the filing of the application:

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. Notwithstanding the grant of this STA or the expiration date specified herein, the station's license will expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., August 23, 2017.
