**RE: FM Translator Station W299BX
Dothan, Alabama
FCC Facility ID # 141166
INTERFERENCE COMPLAINT**

Dear Madame Secretary:

On behalf of our client Fox Broadcasting Corporation, LLC, licensee of FM Broadcast Station WFXX, 107.7 MHz, Georgiana, Alabama, and pursuant to Section 74.1203 of the Commission's Rules, this is to submit a formal interference complaint against co-channel FM Translator Station W299BX, Dothan, Alabama. According to the FCC's CDBS database, W299BX is authorized to Alabama Media, LLC.

It isn't clear to us whether W299BX is operating legally, as it had a construction permit rescinded (File No. BPFT-20161026ABO) apparently after it had constructed the facility proposed in BPFT-20161026ABO and filed a Form 350 covering license application (File No. BLFT-20161109ABT).

It is our understanding that W299BX is operating 24 hours per day, 7 days a week, and rebroadcasting AM Broadcast Station WCNF, 700 kHz, Dothan, Alabama.

Station WFXX has listeners (or people who would like to listen to WFXX) in the communities of Enterprise, Level Plains and Coffee Springs, Alabama, and at least nine of them have notified Fox Broadcasting Corporation that they were experiencing interference with their reception of WFXX. Copies of these statements are attached. These statements are evidence that station W299BX has caused interference to WFXX in south Alabama.

The pertinent provisions of Section 74.1203 of the Commission's Rules are as follows [emphasis supplied]:

(a) An authorized FM translator or booster station will not be permitted to continue to operate if it causes any actual interference to:

(1) The transmission of any authorized broadcast station;
or

(2) The reception of the input signal of any TV translator, TV booster, FM translator or FM booster station; or

(3) The direct reception by the public of the off-the-air signals of any authorized broadcast station including TV Channel 6 stations, Class D (secondary) noncommercial educational FM stations, and previously authorized and operating FM translators and FM booster stations. **Interference will be considered to occur whenever reception of a regularly used signal is impaired by the signals radiated by the FM translator or booster station, regardless of the quality of such reception, the strength of the signal so used, or the channel on which the protected signal is transmitted.**

(b) **If interference cannot be properly eliminated by the application of suitable techniques, operation of the offending FM translator or booster station shall be suspended and shall not be resumed until the interference has been eliminated.** Short test transmissions may be made during the period of suspended operation to check the efficacy of remedial measures. If a complainant refuses to permit the FM translator or booster licensee to apply remedial techniques which demonstrably will eliminate the interference without impairment

to the original reception, the licensee of the FM translator or booster station is absolved of further responsibility for that complaint.

* * * * *

As translator station W299BX is clearly interfering with the reception by the public of primary station WFXX, it is in violation of Section 74.1203 of the Rules, and Fox Broadcasting Corporation, LLC must insist that the licensee of station W299BX reduce power or suspend operations until it can demonstrate that it will not interfere with WFXX in areas where it can be heard off-air, were a translator not interfering, including the Alabama communities noted above. If W299BX attempts to operate, it must do so at its currently licensed facility, not with the facilities specified in File No. BPFT-20161026ABO.


