Dear Mr. Price:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 31, 2017. TMMO requests a further extension of the STA granted on December 2, 2014, to continue to operate with DA parameters at variance to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters.<sup>1</sup> In support of its request, TMMO states that it plans to file the application after completion of all required repairs.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and TMMO



may continue to operate with DA parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits to allow time to file the application for a new license. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. TMMO must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **March 5, 2018**.
