Dear Mr. Price:

This is in reference to the request filed on August 2, 2017. TMMO requests a further extension of the STA to continue operating with an ND antenna to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application due to the numerous required repairs.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, TMMO stated that additional time will be needed to complete all repairs and measurements before filing the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and TMMO may continue to operate ND using tower #1 (ARSN 1224828) with a maximum of 0.625 kW day

and 0.25 kW night. TMMO must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. TMMO must submit a 302 application after all repairs have been completed to update all operating parameters if any changes are noted. Otherwise TMMO must submit an e-mail to my attention to certify the date the station resumed licensed operations with negligible changes to the operating parameters as shown on the last license (BML-20150806ABM).

This authority expires on **March 6, 2018**.
