INTERFERENCE COMPLAINT

1. Stewards of Sound, Inc. (“Stewards”) hereby submits this complaint against WPRX, Inc. (“WPRX”) based on interference caused by WPRX’s FM Translator Station W279DD, Hudson, WI,¹ to reception by regular listeners of primary station WWIB, Facility ID 63428, Hallie, WI. Stewards is the licensee of WWIB. Both W279DD and WWIB operate on Channel 279, so the interference is co-channel and not resolvable except by modification of the translator’s facilities or cessation of operation of the translator.

2. Section 74.1203(a) of the Commission’s Rules provides as follows:

§ 74.1203 Interference.

(a) An authorized FM translator or booster station will not be permitted to continue to operate if it causes any actual interference to:

(3) The direct reception by the public of the off-the-air signals of any authorized broadcast station..... Interference will be considered to occur whenever reception of a regularly used signal is impaired by the signals radiated by the FM translator or booster station, regardless of the quality of such reception, the strength of the signal so used, or the channel on which the protected signal is transmitted.

¹ The community of license is misspelled as “Husdon” in CDBS Station Search.

3. Stewards has received complaints from regular listeners to WWIB that they can no longer receive WWIB because of interference.² The listeners are located in the geographic area between the WWIB and W279DD transmitter sites, so it is apparent that W279DD is the source of the interference. Attached as Exhibit 1 are complaints from ten listeners. Also attached as Exhibit 2 is a map showing where the listeners are located, along with the 60, 50, and 40 dBu contours of both W279DD and WWIB.³ The licensee has confirmed to counsel that the initial complaints were spontaneous and that none of the listeners is affiliated with WWIB or a family member of any WWIB owner or employee.

4. In each case, the complaint was initiated by the listener, either in writing or by telephone. WWIB then contacted the listeners to flesh out each of the elements the Commission requires:

- a. Contact information for the listener.
- b. Type of device used to listen to the station.
- c. Date when interference was observed.
- d. Statement that the complainant is a regular listener.
- e. Locations where the listener used to be able to hear the primary station but no longer can.

² W279DD has been operating with its present facilities since May of 2016; see File No. BLFT-20160502ABR. Stewards started receiving complaints many months ago, and the complaints indicated that interference started in the summer of 2016. Stewards deferred filing this complaint until it had an opportunity to approach WRPX privately and also had time to document complaints carefully to meet the Commission's requirements for interference complaints. Stewards did call the interference problem to the attention of WRPX's technical consultant, but WRPX has not taken any action to modify the translator's facilities.

³ The service contours are shown only for informational purposes. Section 73.1203(a) of the Rules explicitly states that interference is prohibited regardless of the primary station's signal strength.


After WWIB completed written narratives of what the listeners said, the reports were submitted back to the listeners, with an opportunity for the listeners to provide additional information; and the listeners then signed the narrative.

5. In sum, the evidence establishes that translator station W279DD is causing interference to reception of WWIB by a significant number of regular listeners to WWIB, WWIB's listeners have complained about the interference and wish to be able to listen to WWIB again, the listeners initiated contact with WWIB, and each listener reviewed and revalidated his/her complaint by supplementing and signing a written report of the details.

6. In light of these circumstances, Stewards requests that the Commission issue a letter directing WRPX to cease operation and not to resume unless and until modified facilities have been authorized and constructed that curtail the reach of W279DD's signal to the east in the direction of WWIB and no longer cause interference to WWIB.

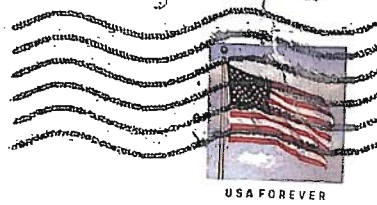

I am concerned that this change in circumstance for Karen may not have a basis other than temporary reception issues, such as seasonal foliage shielding or atmospheric ducting. Since Karen's interference issue was sustained over a longer period of time, I think this temporary improvement may not disqualify her complaint, but might be held tentatively to be proved out in the coming several weeks. 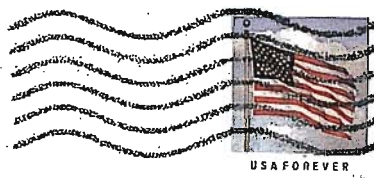

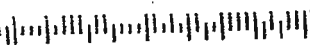


