Dear Mr. Withers:

This is in reference to the request filed May 11, 2007, on behalf of Pacific Broadcasting of Missouri LLC (PBM). PBM requests further extension of the special temporary authority (STA) granted on August 30, 2005, to operate Station KTKY from a site other than the licensed site.¹ In support of the request, PBM states that the Commission is aware of the circumstances requiring KTKY to operate at variance to its license.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control and has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

¹ KTKY is licensed to Refugio, Texas, for operation on Channel 291C3 (106.1 MHz) with effective radiated power (ERP) of 25 kilowatts (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain (HAAT) of 100 meters. Construction Permit BPH-20000613AAF authorizes relocation of the transmitter, a change in the community of license to Taft, Texas, an upgrade to Channel 293C2 (106.5 MHz), an increase in ERP to 50 kilowatts (H&V) and an increase in the HAAT to 136 meters.

Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KTKY may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Channel	291 (106.1 MHz)
Effective radiated power:	0.15 kilowatt (H&V)
Antenna height:	
above ground:	12 meters
above mean sea level:	30 meters
above average terrain:	14 meters

PBM must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **May 14, 2008**.
