Dear Counsel:

This letter concerns minor change application BPED-20161216ABE (Application) submitted by the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas (Board), licensee of FM station KUAF(FM), Fayetteville, Arkansas.¹

Pursuant to Section 17.4(a) of the Commission's Rules,² any proposed construction of a new antenna structure or proposed alteration of an existing antenna structure that requires Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) notification also requires registration with the Commission prior to construction or alteration. Our records indicate that the proposed antenna structure has not been registered. FCC antenna structure registration may be accomplished electronically via the Internet at http://wireless.fcc.gov/antenna/.

Following FCC registration of the antenna structure, a curative amendment to the Application, which includes the FCC Antenna Structure Registration Number (ASRN), must be submitted to the Commission. If the antenna structure cannot be registered with the Commission within 90 days of the date of this letter, Board must notify the Commission, in writing, concerning the delay.³ In the event that further difficulties with the registration process occur following Board's initial response to this letter, Board must provide the Commission with written updates concerning the structure registration process every 60 days thereafter.⁴

³ If the structure cannot be registered within the initial 90 day period, the first response to this letter shall be filed in triplicate with the Secretary of the Commission, and shall contain a specific narrative of the actions taken to obtain FAA approval and FCC antenna structure registration.

⁴ Each 60 day update shall be filed in triplicate with the Secretary of the Commission, and shall report specific actions toward securing FAA approval and FCC antenna structure registration taken by the applicant and its agents since the filing of the previous report.

Further action on the Application will be withheld for a period of 90 days from the date of this letter to provide Board an opportunity to respond. Failure to respond within this time period or to provide written updates as required will result in the dismissal of the Application pursuant to Section 73.3568(a)(1) of the Commission's Rules.⁵
