Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to: 1) the special temporary authority ("STA") granted to Pentecostal Temple Development Corporation ("PTD") November 9, 2007, to operate Station WGBN with reduced power; and 2) counsel's letter of November 16, 2007, which requests modification of the STA to authorize operation with an emergency nondirectional antenna and reduced power.

Counsel corrects the information supplied in the original STA request to indicate that Station WGBN is licensed to operate with a directional antenna and that one of the licensed towers collapsed in a storm, rendering the directional antenna inoperative.

Section 73.1680 of the Commission's rules provides for operation with emergency antenna facilities following damage to authorized antenna systems, provided that an informal request for continued use of an emergency antenna is filed with the Commission within 24 hours. In particular, Section 73.1680(b)(1) provides that AM stations using an emergency nondirectional antenna in lieu of authorized directional facilities shall operate with power reduced to 25 percent or less of the nominal licensed power, or a higher power, not exceeding licensed power, while insuring that the radiated field strength does not exceed that authorized in any given azimuth.

Counsel's letter will be treated as a Petition for Reconsideration of the initial STA grant. On reconsideration, we find that the requested STA operation complies with Section 73.1680. STA will be modified as requested.

Accordingly, the request for modification of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WGBN may continue to operate with an emergency nondirectional antenna and reduced power not to exceed 0.25 kilowatt daytime and 0.00175 kilowatt (1.75 watts) nighttime. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. PTD must

notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. PTD must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **February 9, 2008**.
