Emergency Antenna and Reduced Power Notification

Dear Ms. Dortch

On behalf of Akal Broadcasting Corporation, licensee of AM broadcast station KGSV, Oildale, California, the Commission is hereby notified, pursuant to Sections 73.1680 (b) (1) and 73.1560 (d) of the rules, that KGSV is operating with an emergency antenna and reduced power due to the loss of its number four tower (ASR 124706) which was brought down by a high wind and rain storm on Sunday, September 3, 2017. KGSV is licensed to operate directionally with a nominal power of 8 kW day and 6 kW night. KGSV is currently operating non-directionally, both night and day, from its number one tower (ASR 1247050) with a nominal power of 1.59 kW (25% of its authorized nighttime power of 6 kW). It is anticipated that downed number four tower will take months to fabricate and replace; accordingly, an STA to operate with the above referenced temporary facilities will be filed within 30 days from the start of such operations.
