This is in reference to the request filed on August 24, 2017. ER requests an extension of the STA granted on April 14, 2016, to continue operating using one of the WERM(AM) towers pending the filing of the required FCC Form 301 application to propose a new permanent facility at the site (due to loss of the licensed site). In support of the request, we note that ER has not yet filed the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and ER may continue to operate with the following facilities:

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. ER must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47CFR 1.1310. We anticipate that ER will be able to file the 301 application in the upcoming months since already operating from one of the existing WERM towers.

This authority expires on March 26, 2018.
