Dear Mr. Henderson:

This is in reference to the request filed on September 29, 2017. STB requests an extension of the STA granted on April 6, 2017, to continue operating with parameters at variance to allow time to file an FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters (due to the resolution of power line related problems).<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, STB states that additional time will be needed to file the application with a new partial proof to change the location of one monitor point.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and STB may continue to operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power

while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. STB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. We anticipate that STB will file the application before the expiration date shown below (along with a final STA extension on that date if a new license has not yet been granted).

This authority expires on **May 3, 2018**.
