Dear Mr. Chiesa:

This is in reference to the request filed on November 13, 2017. RVCM requests a final extension of the STA granted on November 13, 2007, to continue operating with a long wire antenna at the construction permit site to allow time to file the FCC Form 302 application.¹ In support of the request, RVCM stated it plans to remain on the air using this STA until able to switch over to automatic PTA operation and file the 302 application in the near future.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and RVCM may continue to operate on 1580 kHz with a 30 foot long wire antenna using a maximum of 0.5

¹ WVZN is licensed for ND operation on 1580 kHz with 0.5 kW day and 0.005 kW night, and BP-20140425AAA authorizes ND operation from the new site using 0.5 kW day and 0.005 kW night.

kW day and 0.005 kW. RVCN must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **June 12, 2018**.
