Dear Mr. Do:

This is in reference to the request filed on November, 20, 2017. Intelli requests an extension of the STA granted on September 17, 2014, to continue to operate with temporary facilities pending the filing of the required FCC Form 301 application.¹ In support of the request, Intelli states that additional time is needed to file the application (to propose a new permanent operation).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and Intelli may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Frequency	1290 KHz
Hours of operation	Unlimited
Operating power	1.25 kW (day), 0.02 kW (night)

¹ KAZA(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1290 kHz with 5 kW day and 0.088 kW night.



It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. Intelli must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. Intelli must file the 301 application to move forward toward resumption of licensed operations (due to loss of the licensed site in 2014).

This authority expires on **June 12, 2018**.
