Dear Mrs. McCauley, I am requesting an extension date for His Sanctuary Ministries USA International Inc., due to damages to our building from Disaster Hurricane Harvey September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2017, address 1717 Turning Basin Dr. Houston, Texas 77021 suite 485. We were given an extension before the hurricane and we were on schedule to launch our radio station KHSX 101.5 FM-LP before the storm actually destroy our new tower and building roof top.


Mrs. McCauley our building engineer on several occasion after the storm tried repairing the stations roof and other parts of the building the devastation hurricane has caused, but unfortunately the engineer stated on last Friday the repairs could take long with obtaining new permits from the city to allow us to put our tower back upon the roof, but first he must repair them safely.

KHSX has complied with the engineering's request to see if we can move the towers in another location on the roof, but now it appears the roof itself need more repairs before we can mount the tower properly on the roof, this is another setback to launch our station in a timely manner. We are asking for an addition 90 days to launch our station to allow the building engineer to complete their repairs so our tower can be mounted and stored in a safe place for all parties said.

We had to purchase another tower due to store damages from Hurricane Harvey and repair windows in the building and the surrounding area. Our office tried until the end to launch but circumstance beyond our control from the act of God has delayed us from launching our new station. We are working through the holidays to make sure this task is complete and safe and trying to get the engineer make sure the roof is safe to mount our equipment.

Mrs. McCauley, please understand our dilemma and note as soon as we get approval to mount our tower on the roof our engineer will work tirelessly to get KHSX 101.5 FM-LP on the air. Hurricane Harvey has caused a lot of devastation to all of us losing 1000's of dollars replacing equipment and etc, we appreciate your understanding and hope to hear from your office soon. The engineer stated they will work hard to assist us, but they have this entire building to make sure it is safe for all tenants.
