Request for Extension of Special Temporary
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Trent:

This letter concerns the request you filed on December 6, 2017, on behalf of CSN International (CSN), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit FM Translator Station K288GT to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that CSN stated that Station K288GT went silent on April 6, 2017, pending the proposed modification of its facilities. The previous STA was granted on June 8, 2017, and expired on December 5, 2017. CSN requests extension of its STA because its modification remains pending. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

CSN's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K288GT to remain silent until April 6, 2018. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station K288GT will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., April 7, 2018.**¹

CSN is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If CSN does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
