Special Temporary Authorization

Dear Mr. Reese:

This is in reference to the request filed January 2, 2008, on behalf of Board of Regents, Nevada System of Higher Education ("NSHE"), licensee of Station KUNV (FM), Las Vegas, Nevada. NSHE requests special temporary authority ("STA") to operate a temporary, low-power FM transmitter in connection with the 2008 Consumer Electronics Show. In support of the request, NSHE states that the transmitter will be operated only once during the event, on January 8, 2008, between the hours of 10:30 and 11:30 a.m., for the purpose of demonstrating new techniques in digital radio, including captioning for the hard of hearing and conditional access for the visually handicapped.

Our review indicates that the public interest would be served by grant of the requested STA, and that interference to other stations is not likely to occur.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. NSHE may operate a temporary transmitter with the following facilities:

Geographic coordinates:	36° 07' 52" N, 115° 05' 04" W (NAD 1927)
Channel	220 (91.9 MHz)
Effective radiated power:	0.001 kilowatt (V only)
Antenna manufacturer and type:	Antenex, type Maxrad quarter-wave vertical whip
Antenna height:	
above ground:	11 meters
above mean sea level:	632 meters
Above average terrain:	-59 meters

It will be necessary to reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received.

NSHE must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **January 9, 2008**.
