Request for Extension of Special Temporary

Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Timmons:

This letter concerns the request you filed on January 17, 2018, on behalf of Ted W. Austin, Jr. (Austin), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit FM Translator Station K222CJ to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that Austin stated that Station K222CJ went silent on June 10, 2017, pending the proposed modification of its facilities. The previous STA was granted on July 21, 2017, and expired on January 17, 2018. Austin requests extension of its STA for technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

Austin's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K222CJ to remain silent until June 10, 2018. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station K222CJ will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., June 11, 2018.

Austin is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If Austin does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
