Dear Mr. Usher:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 9, 2018. LCL requests an extension of the STA granted on June 15, 2017, to continue operating ND at night with reduced power to allow time to complete all required work on the damaged nighttime antenna system.\(^1\) In support of the request, LCL states that all necessary parts have been installed, and that a short amount of additional time is needed to complete a tune up before it can resume licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond
 the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve
 the problem.

We note that the previous STA expired on September 15, 2017, therefore the authority granted herein will not cover the period between the expiration of the prior STA and the filing of the instant request, and is without prejudice as to whatever action the Commission may take with respect to operation

during that time period.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and LCL may continue to operate ND at night with a maximum of 0.25 kW (with no change to the licensed daytime 5 kW operation). LCL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. LCL must submit a brief e-mail to my attention to certify the date the station resumed licensed operations per BZ-20010727ACD with negligible changes (or to state that an FCC Form 302 application has been filed to update all operating parameters).

This authority expires on August 12, 2018.
