Dear Mr. Davis:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 24, 2018. CCL requests an extension of the STA granted on April 24, 2014, to operate with parameters at variance pending the grant of BMML-20170713AIO.¹ In support of the request, we note the license application remains under review by our staff at this time.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:


- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and CCL may continue to operate with parameters at variance and/or reduced power if needed based upon the information submitted in BMML-20170713AIO. CCL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

¹ WREC(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 600 kHz with 5 kW (day and night) using different patterns.

This authority expires on **August 14, 2018**.
