Special Temporary Authorization

Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed January 11, 2008, on behalf of SCA License Corporation ("SLC"). SLC requests special temporary authority ("STA") to operate Station WYLL during daytime hours with its licensed nighttime antenna system and reduced power.¹ In support of the request, SLC states that bridge construction is underway immediately adjacent to the WYLL daytime site, with several tall cranes in use. SLC states that operation from the nighttime site during those times when the cranes are in use is necessary for the protection of construction workers. SLC further states that operation from the nighttime site during daytime hours with reduced power of 15 kilowatts will provide full protection to other licensed stations.

Our review indicates that the public interest will be served by grant of the requested STA.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WYLL may operate during daytime hours from its licensed nighttime site, with reduced power not to exceed 15 kilowatts, only as necessary for the protection of workers as described above. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. SLC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **July 11, 2008**.

¹ WYLL is licensed for operation on 1160 kHz with 50 kilowatts, unlimited hours, employing separate transmitter sites and different directional antenna patterns during daytime and nighttime hours. (DA-2-U).
