Dear Applicant:

The staff has under consideration the above-captioned application for a new FM translator station.

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 1.1910, the Commission examines applications to determine if the applicant is delinquent in any non-tax debt owed to the Commission.<sup>1</sup> On January 18, 2018, the applicant's attorney and engineer were notified that Metz, Inc. was delinquent on the payment of debts owed to the Federal Communications Commission. The red light letter indicated that if full payment or satisfactory arrangement to pay the delinquent debt was not made within 30 days of the date of the letter, the application or other request for benefit would be dismissed. The Commission has not received payment of the debts identified in the red light letter, nor have satisfactory payment arrangements been made. Furthermore, we have not received any response to the red light letter.

Accordingly, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Sections 1.1910(b)(3) and 0.283, the application BNPFT-20171208ACB IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
