Dear Mr. Cherry:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 9, 2018. Cherry requests a further extension of the STA originally granted on February 10, 2015, to resume operation with temporary facilities at an alternate site to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application for a new permanent facility.¹ In support of the request, Cherry states that additional time is needed to prepare and file the application, and our records show the station has been silent since September 11, 2017, due to hurricane damage.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Notwithstanding the grant of this STA or the expiration date specified herein, the station's license will expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., September 12, 2018. See Pub. Law No. 104-104, 110 Stat. 56, Section 403(l)(1996)

¹ WPUL(AM) is licensed for ND operation on 1590 kHz with 1 kW (day) and 0.32 kW (night).

and *Order, Silent Station Authorizations*, FCC 96-218 (released May 17, 1996). *See also Public Notice, Expedited Processing of Applications Filed by Silent Stations*, DA 96-818 (May 22, 1996). Cherry must file an electronic notification of resumption of operations on the same date STA operations resume, along with a notification email sent to Denise.Williams@fcc.gov.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and Cherry may commence operations with previously authorized facilities shown below:

Geographic coordinates	29° 12' 07" N, 81° 01' 29" W (NAD 1927)
Frequency	1590 KHz
Hours of operation	Unlimited
Operating power	0.25 kW day, 0.32 kW night
Antenna type	Existing 24 meter tower
Antenna efficiency	Unknown

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. Cherry must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **September 1, 2018**.
