Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Caron Broadcasting, Inc. (corporate name change to Salem Communications Holding Corporation in process) ("CBI") permittee of W245CY, Facility ID.No. 145205, Cleveland, Ohio; we hereby request tolling of the W245CY construction period.

The W245CY construction permit (BMPFT-20180117AAP) is currently scheduled to expire on March 7, 2018. On February 20, 2018, however, Rubber City Radio Group, Inc. filed a Petition for Reconsideration for the grant of the modified construction permit for W245CY (BMPFT-20180117AAP). Under Section 73.598(b)(2) of the Commission's Rules, the period of construction for an original construction permit shall toll when construction is prevented because the "grant of the permit is the subject of administrative or judicial review (*i.e.*, petitions for reconsideration and applications for review of the grant of the construction permit pending before the Commissions...)."

CBI accordingly requests that the construction period W245CY be tolled until resolution of the pending administrative appeal.

CBI certifies that it is not subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. Section 862.
