Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed August 9, 2007, on behalf of Nassau Broadcasting II, LLC ("NB2"), for extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on February 16, 2007, to operate Station WEEEX with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits.¹ In support of the request, NB2 states that it has completed repairs and filed an application for direct measurement of power, which remains pending.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made substantial progress toward restoring licensed operation. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WEEEX may continue to operate with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor

¹ WEEEX is licensed for operation on 1230 kHz with 0.84 kilowatt daytime and 1 kilowatt nighttime, employing a directional antenna during daytime hours only (DA-D-U).

points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. NB2 must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **July 17, 2008**.
