Dear Mr. Kitchen:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 5, 2018. TMMO requests a further extension of the STA granted on December 2, 2014, to continue to operate with DA parameters at variance to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application due to repairs made over the past 3 years.¹ In support of its request, TMMO states that it plans to file the application with a partial proof to update all operating parameters (after completion of all remaining repairs).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and TMMO

may continue to operate with parameters at variance and reduced power if needed to maintain monitor points within licensed limits. TMMO must reduce power or cease operations if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **September 27, 2018**.
